Lorena FFA Alumni latest updates

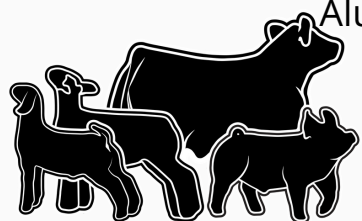

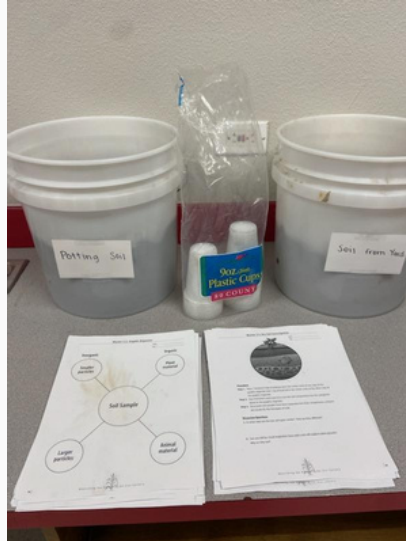
